- "encourage" others through the sharing of their own challenges: "You have to talk about your challenges, your fears. They need to know that you've been through some things." Vulnerability and humility go a long way in encouraging others.
- "elevate" others: "You want to make sure everyone is reaching their highest potential. You want them to thrive, not survive. People already have their own survival strategy." Because there is no end to better, there is no end to elevate.



• "empower" others: "Empowerment is not speaking up for those who can't speak up for themselves. You help people find their voice. A mentor leader empowers those around them to make a difference and find their voice. A mentor is called to serve everyone"
